## Sermon Title: Second Wind

---

**Scripture:** Romans 8:1-6

---

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, <sup>2</sup> because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you<sup>Ⓜ</sup> free from the law of sin and death. <sup>3</sup> For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh,<sup>Ⓜ</sup> God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering.<sup>Ⓜ</sup> And so he condemned sin in the flesh,<sup>4</sup> in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

<sup>5</sup> Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. <sup>6</sup> The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace.
